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Eko STEM programi u knjižnici Augusta Cesarca

Sažetak

U sklopu projekta Zelena knjižnica za zeleni Zagreb te kroz suradnju s lokalnim udrugama i institucijama knjižničari Knjižnice Augusta Cesarca provode aktivnosti osvješćivanja mlađih i odraslih korisnika o ekološkim pitanjima i održivosti. Inovativnim eko STEM radionicama uz interdisciplinarni pristup i primjenu suvremenih tehnologija knjižničari potiču digitalno i ekološko opismenjavanje korisnika. Osim toga, knjižničari razvijaju vlastite kompetencije o ekološkom i održivom razvoju uz upotrebu digitalnih tehnologija.

Eko STEM radionice koje se kontinuirano provode u knjižnici su: Stvor svoj STEM vrt uz primjenu zelenih tehnologija i AQ:bit – radionica građanske znanosti. Na radionicama se koriste Arduino i AQ:bit tehnologije te se programira micro:bit.

Cilj posterskog izlaganja je prikazati primjere dobre prakse u provođenju ekoloških i digitalnih programa u Knjižnici Augusta Cesarca.

Eco STEM Programs at the August Cesarec Library

Abstract

As part of the Green Library for a Green Zagreb project and through collaboration with local associations and institutions, librarians at the August Cesarec Library conduct activities to raise awareness among young and adult patrons about environmental issues and sustainability. Through innovative eco-STEM workshops, using an interdisciplinary approach and the application of modern technologies, librarians encourage digital and ecological literacy among patrons. Additionally, librarians are developing their own competencies in ecological and sustainable development through the use of digital technologies.

The eco-STEM workshops that are continuously conducted in the library include: Create Your STEM Garden with Green Technologies and AQ:bit– Citizen Science Workshop. These workshops use Arduino and AQ:bit technologies, and micro:bit programming is implemented.

The aim of the poster presentation is to showcase examples of best practices in conducting ecological and digital programs at the August Cesarec Library.
