Zavičajna kuća GKMM-a – Rasuti muzej GKMM-a

Sažetak

Program „Zavičajna kuća GKMM-a Split“ iniciran je 2019. godine donacijom kućne biblioteke pok. Jakše Fiamenga GKMM-u, nastavljen je 2021. donacijom ostavštine Ljube Stipišića Delmate i pokretanjem Knjižnice Dalmatina, te 2022. donacijom ostavštine Miljenka Smoje. To je program u razvitu s ciljem da se svaka knjižnica u mreži strateški posveti nekoj od znamenitih osoba Splita i Dalmacije. U fazi je evaluacije prijavljeni europski projekt infrastrukturnog preuređenja Knjižnice Spinut u duhu glazbenika Dina Dvornika. U tijeku je suradnja s Općinom Šolta na realizaciji spomen-sobe Vesne Parun u Knjižnici Grohote.

Realizacija projekata u sklopu programa „Zavičajne kuće GKMM-a“, tzv. rasutog muzeja GKMM-a, primjer je kako knjižnični programi očuvanja baštine koreliraju s implementacijom suvremenih smjernica u razvoju narodnih knjižnica.

GKMM ovim programom, na specifičan način, realizira svoju misiju – povezuje tradicionalno i suvremeno, lokalno i globalno, održava ideju kontinuiteta ljudske misli i djelovanja, te je u bliskom kontaktu sa svojim korisnicima svih generacija i zajedno s njima kreira brojne nove programe.

Local Heritage House of Marko Marulic City Library Split - The Scattered Museum

Abstract

The Local Heritage House of Marko Marulić City Library Split program was launched in 2019 with the donation of the late Jakša Fiamengo's personal library to the Marko Marulić City Library. It expanded in 2021 with the donation of Ljubo Stipišić Delmata's legacy and the establishment of the Dalmatina Library, followed by the inclusion of Miljenko Smoje's legacy in 2022. The program is continuously evolving, with the aim of having each library in the network strategically dedicated to one of the distinguished figures from Split and Dalmatia. A European project for the infrastructural renovation of the Spinut Library, featuring a memorial corner honouring the musician Dino Dvornik, is currently under review. Ongoing collaboration with the Municipality of Šolta includes the development of a memorial room for Vesna Parun in the Grohote Library.

The Local Heritage House program, also known as the Scattered Museum of Marko Marulić City Library, exemplifies how heritage preservation initiatives in libraries align with modern guidelines for public library development. Through this program, the Marko Marulić City Library fulfills its mission in a distinctive way - bridging tradition and innovation, connecting the local with the global, upholding the continuity of human thought and creativity, and fostering close relationships with its users across generations, co-creating a wide range of new programs with them.

Biografije

Grozdana Ribičić je knjižničarska savjetnica i ravnateljica Gradske knjižnice Marka Marulića Split od 2019. godine. Pokretačica je, zajedno s velikim brojim kolega i suradnika, brojnih programa i projekata usmijerenih na popularizaciju knjige, čitanja i knjižnice. Hrvatsko knjižničarsko društvo u njezinu je mandatu dodijelilo Gradskoj knjižnici Marka Marulića Split priznanje „Knjižnica godine“, a Grad Split dodijelio joj je 2024. osobnu nagradu Grada Splita za promicanje čitanja i pismenosti te za unaprjeđenje knjižničarske struke.

Željka Alajbeg koordinatorica je Knjižnice Grohote GKMM-a, u kojoj radi od 1997. godine. Utemeljiteljica je Zavičajne zbirke svoje knjižnice te aktivna sudionica šoltanskih kulturnih događanja, za što joj je Općina Šolta dodijelila javno priznanje 2012. godine te nagradu 2023. Suradnica je i autorica priloga otočnog časopisa Bašćina. Članica je organizacijskih odbora manifestacija Ča – more – judi (u sklopu Marulićevih dana HNK-a Split) i Dječji Pričigin (u sklopu Festivala pričanja priča Pričigin).

Biographies

Grozdana Ribičić is a senior librarian and has served as the Director of the Marko Marulić City Library Split since 2019. Alongside a dedicated team of colleagues and collaborators, she has launched numerous programs and projects focused on promoting books, reading, and library services. During her tenure, the Croatian Library Association awarded the Marko Marulić City Library Split the Library of the Year recognition. In 2024, the City of Split presented her with the Personal Award of the City of Split for promoting reading and literacy, as well as advancing the library profession.

Željka Alajbeg is the coordinator of the Grohote Library, where she has worked since 1997. She is the founder of the Local Heritage Collection of her library and an active participant in cultural events on the island of Šolta, for which she received public recognition from the Municipality of Šolta in 2012 and an award in 2023. She is a contributor and author in the island magazine "Bašćina". She is also a member of the organizing committees for the events Ča – more – judi (part of the Marulić Days of the Croatian National Theatre Split) and Dječji Pričigin (Children's Storytelling Festival Pričigin).
