Sporom modom prema održivosti: eko aktivizam u Knjižnicama Novi Zagreb

Sažetak

Postersko izlaganje naslova „Sporom modom prema održivosti: eko aktivizam u Knjižnicama Novi Zagreb“ usmjereni je na informiranje korisnika o važnosti spore mode putem predavanja, radionica i edukativnih aktivnosti. Fokus je na edukaciji o ekološkim i socijalnim problemima u modnoj industriji te poticanju svijesti o utjecaju proizvodnje odjeće na okoliš. Program uključuje i izložbe na temu spore mode u knjižnicama, prva javna eko aktivistička izložba nazvana - Zašto spora moda? održana je u Službi nabave i obrade održana u Službi nabave i obrade u Sloboštini, a druga u Knjižnici Sloboština. Također, prvo predavanje, koje je održano u Knjižnici Vjekoslava Majera, obuhvatilo je niz tema brze mode, koja rezultira proizvodnjom velike količine jeftine i nekvalitetne odjeće, često u uvjetima koji krše ljudska prava i zagađuju planet. Cilj programa je educirati korisnike o održivim modnim praksama, korištenju ekoloških materijala i odgovornom pristupu modi. Program je odlično prihvaćen u lokalnoj zajednici, a svrha je osvijestiti stanovnike Novog Zagreba o njihovo ulozi u stvaranju održive budućnosti kroz ekološku odgovornost.

Towards Sustainability with Slow Fashion: Eco-activism in the Libraries of Novi Zagreb

Abstract

The poster presentation titled Towards sustainability with slow fashion: eco-activism in the Libraries of Novi Zagreb aims to inform users about the importance of slow fashion through lectures, workshops, and educational activities. The focus is on educating about the ecological and social issues in the fashion industry and raising awareness about the environmental impact of clothing production. The program also includes exhibitions on the topic of slow fashion in libraries. The first public eco-activist exhibition, named Why slow fashion?, was held in the Acquisitions and Cataloguing Department in Sloboština, and the second one in the Sloboština Library. Additionally, the first lecture, held at the Vjekoslav Majer Library, covered a range of topics on fast fashion, which results in the production of large quantities of cheap and low-quality clothing, often under conditions that violate human rights and pollute the planet. The goal of the program is to educate users about sustainable fashion practices, the use of ecological materials, and a responsible approach to fashion. The program has been well-received in the local community, and its purpose is to raise awareness among the residents of Novi Zagreb about their role in creating a sustainable future through ecological responsibility.
