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Natura Obscura – zelena inicijativa u knjižničarstvu: motivacija i obrazovne potrebe

Sažetak:

Poticanje čitanja kroz zelene inicijative se pokazalo iznimno korisnim i praktičnim zbog promicanja dviju neodvojivih radnji, a to su čitanje i kretanje. Na tragu promicanja čitanja na nekonvencionalnim mjestima, opremanja planinarskih domova knjigama, promicanja kretanja i ekološke svijesti, 2019. godine nastao je projekt Natura Obscura – knjige na planine! u suradnji Knjižnice Marije Jurić Zagorke i Planinarskog društva Izletnik iz Zagreba. Knjigama je opskrbljeno 8 planinarskih obitavališta. Hrvatski planinarski savez pridružio se projektu donirajući veću količinu svojih izdanja. U 2021. godini u projekt su uključeni mladi kako bi ih se odvratilo od izolacije, potaknuto na boravljenje u prirodi i čitanje lektire na nekonvencionalan način. Tako se projektu priključuju Agencija za strukovno obrazovanje i obrazovanje odraslih, Industrijska strojarska škola i Tehnička škola Ruđer Bošković. Izlet na Medvednicu i sat lektire održao se s književnikom Damirom Karakašem koji je učenicima lektirni sat učinio mnogo zanimljivijim. U 2023. godini suradnja je nastavljena s Komisijom za čitanje pri HKD-u donacijom knjiga za odrasle u sklopu osnivanja nogometnog čitateljskog kluba u Drnišu u suradnji s Narodnom knjižnicom Drniš i Nogometnim klubom DOŠK.

Natura Obscura - green initiative in librarianship: motivation and educational needs

Abstract:

Encouraging reading through green initiatives has proven to be extremely beneficial and practical, as it promotes two inseparable activities: reading and physical movement. In line with promoting reading in unconventional places, equipping mountain lodges with books, encouraging physical activity, and raising ecological awareness, the project Natura Obscura was launched in 2019 in collaboration between the Marija Jurić Zagorka Library and the Izletnik Mountaineering Association from Zagreb. Eight mountain shelters were supplied with books. The Croatian Mountaineering Association joined the project by donating many its publications. In 2021, the project involved young people to steer them away from isolation and encourage them to spend time in nature and read their required reading in an unconventional way. Thus, the Agency for Vocational and Adult Education, the Industrial Engineering School, and the Ruđer Bošković Technical School joined the project. An excursion to Medvednica and a reading class were held with writer Damir Karakaš, who made the class much more engaging for the students. In 2023, the collaboration continued with the Reading Commission of the Croatian Library Association (HKD), through the donation of books for adults, as part of the establishment of a football reading club in Drniš in cooperation with the Drniš Public Library and the DOŠK Football Club.
